

Enoplolaimus denticulatus Warwick, 1970
(Fig. 51)

Description. Body length 3.4–4.6 mm. Maximum diameter 60–86 μm ($a = 53$ –61). Cuticle smooth. Inner surfaces of lips with semi-lunar striations. Six long cephalic setae fairly stout, equal in length, up to 2 h.d. long: four shorter submedian setae more slender, up to 0.9 h.d. Numerous long cervical setae in male, up to 1 h.d. long. Female with single ring of six short cervical setae. Tail 4.0–5.5 a.b.d.

Spicules straight, 53–60 μm long, distal tip strongly hooked and bearing fine denticles.

Supplement 2.8–3.3 a.b.d. in front of cloaca.

Vulva at 60–67% of body length.

Distribution. Exe estuary; Isles of Scilly (intertidal sand).

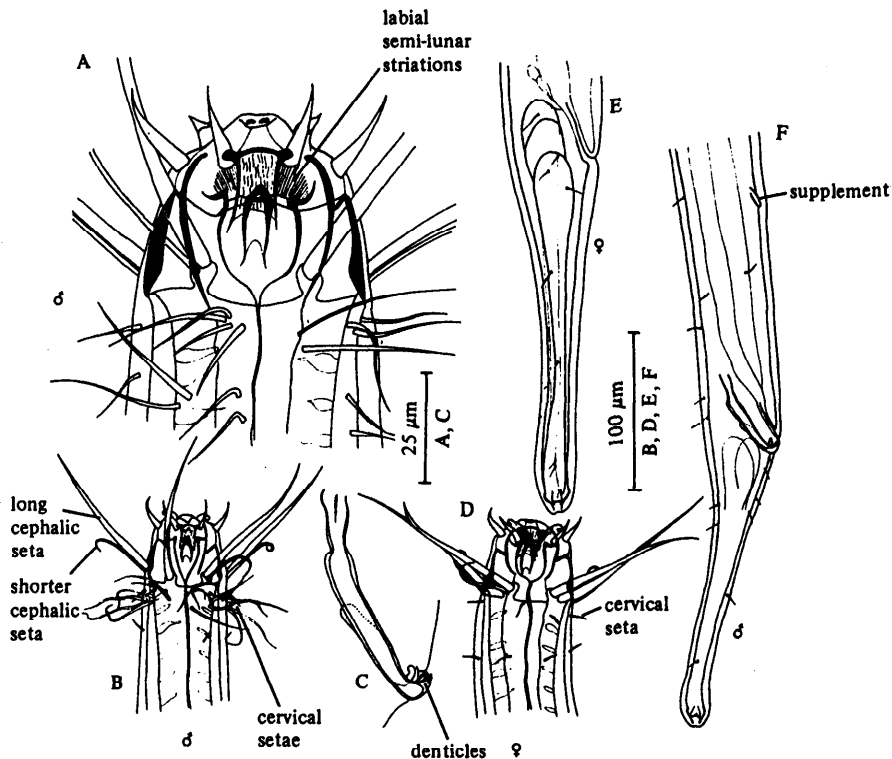


Fig. 51. *Enoplolaimus denticulatus*. A, Detail of male head; B, Male head; C, Spicules and gubernaculum; D, Female head; E, Female tail; F, Male tail. Original.
