5. M. FILIFORMIS, n. sp. (Plate IX. figs. 7, 8.) Female, length $\frac{1}{44}$, breadth $\frac{1}{1111}$.

External Characters.—Body long and narrow, scarcely tapering at all anteriorly, but narrowing behind vulva, and thence onwards, so as to terminate in a long filiform extremity. Head truncate; no setæ.

Esophagus $\frac{1}{5}$ th of total length. *Intestine* sparingly covered with fat-particles. *Anus* $\frac{1}{160}$ " from posterior extremity. *Vulva* considerably behind middle of body.

Male, not seen.

Hab. About liverwort, from pier of bridge just above water-level, river Blackwater.
