

2. T. PARVUS, n. sp. (Plate XIII. figs. 185, 186.)

Female, length $\frac{1}{4}\frac{1}{5}$ "", breadth $\frac{1}{12}\frac{1}{5}\frac{1}{10}$ "".

External Characters.—Body tapering at both extremities, especially at posterior, commencing behind vulva. Head truncate, naked. Striae of integument imperceptible.

Pharyngeal cavity indistinct. *Œsophagus* about $\frac{1}{7}$ th of total length. *Intestine* sparingly covered with hepatic particles. *Anus* $\frac{1}{3}\frac{1}{4}\frac{1}{5}$ " from posterior extremity. *Vulva* posterior to middle of body. *Ocelli*

Male, not seen.

Hab. Small green weed from tide-pools, Falmouth.
