Αδρανής = listless, inactive.

Female. Head triangular. Antennae short, 3-jointed. Body thick, squat, cylindrical.

Thorax 6-jointed - 4 joints of same size, last two narrower; last joint with 2 divergent corneous projections. Mouth surrounded by many small maxillae; 1st pair simple, flat, triangular. 4 biramous legs; exopods flat, triangular; endopods terminated by short spines like teeth, & retractile.

Eggs in abdomen, surrounded by hyaline membrane

Microscopic in size about 2 mm.
