Head fused with first segt: gen segt not divided
abdomen 3-segd: caudal rami short. First anten-
nae 8-segd: exopod of 2nd antennae 1-segd, with
1 terminal and 1 marginal seta. First endopod 2-
segd, basal segt widened: end segt small, with
2 claws. Basal expansion of 5th legs well de-
veloped. Second basipod of first leg in male
with a very large curved spine: second en-
dopod modified for prehension -
