

Lepimacrus, valid Caligoida Caligidae.

λεπίτις = scale or shell : μακρός = long.

Carapace with parallel sides and a pointed anterior angle. Frontal plates narrow: Thoracic area very small. First Thorax joint shorter than others, armed with 4 plates, v 2 central ones larger & separated by a wide suture: second joint a little longer than first, its 2 plates narrow, inclined toward each other & meeting at a center: third joint largest with a single dorsal plate, split for half its length, v narrow tips curved outward. Abdomen short: anal laminae large; both showing but little in a post. angle between dorsal plates.
