Linckia and polyos. hide or skin

Body pyriforme, made up of 10 seg't. Carapace
(head + 1st seg't) long & broad: 2nd + 3rd seg't broad
but short: 4th, seg't and 5th, abruptly narrower.
Gen. seg't broader than long in ♀. Abdomen
with 4 very small seg't: anal laminae as wide
as long. No eyes visible. First antennae 8-
jointed, with setae: second pair 4-jointed, ter-
minating in a hook.
First 4 pairs of feet biramous, rami 3-jointed,
except the 4th endopod, which is 2-jointed
5th feet rudimentary. 1-jointed.
