MESO = half and χῆρος = bereft, deserted.

Body slender, elongated, the anterior division only slightly dilated. Tail slender and in ♀ composed of only 3 segts. Caudal rami long and narrow. First antennae slender and like those of *Asterocheres*. Mandible palp small, 1-jointed. Swimming legs strong, the spines broad, dagger-like. Last legs 2-jointed.
