Body conical, rounded in front. First antennae 7-seg'd, geniculate in ♂. Second pair with a small 3-seg'd. exopod. Mds. with a large bibrarose palp; mxpds. rather large and bearing an elongated claw. First legs with 2-seg'd endopod, 3-seg'd. exopod. Next 3 pairs with both rami 3-seg'd. Fifth pair 2-seg'd.
