(...Dana's Lepidopus, which was preoccupied in 1770 by Gouan for a genus of fishes. That this is a valid genus and not a synonym for Perissopus, as suggested by Steenstrup & Lutken in 1861, by Brady in 1883, and again by Bassett-Smith in 1899)

(Description given:--

Corpus oblongum, posticè sensim latius. Carapax subquadratus, posticè paulo latior, margine postico vix arcuato. Segmenta duo sequentia subaequa, alis grandibus, fere rotundatis. Abdomen oblongum, carapace valde longius, posticè non angustius, paulo bilobatum, lobis rotundatis. Antennae posticae ad apicem longè falci-formes et denticulis biserialis armatae, articulo penultimo subquadrato. Pedes paris secundi grandes, articulo penultimo ad apicem spinigero, ultimo crassissimo, superficie terminali oblongâ, squamatâ, squamulis spinulâ armatis.
